POLICY FOR SUBSIDIES TO BTTA REPRESENTATIVE PLAYERS

BTTA Representative at Qld State Titles

Subsidies will be paid by BTTA to BTTA representatives at the annual Qld State Titles where the event is held outside of the city of Brisbane, Sunshine Coast, Gold Coast and Noosa regions.

- 1** The subsidies payable each year will be:
 - a) \$1,000 for BTTA junior representatives in total;
 - b) \$1,000 for BTTA senior representatives in total; and
 - c) \$1,000 for BTTA veteran representatives in total.
- 1.1** If the total number of representatives is less than 5, a maximum amount of \$200 per representative will be paid.
- 1.2** A representative will only receive one (1) subsidy per year for one (1) event. (a or b) or (c or b).
- 1.3** Any representative who is reported by either tournament officials or Team Manager for inappropriate behaviour will not be paid a subsidy.
- 1.4** Subsidies will be payable to representative following the event and receipt of the Team Manager's Report to the Centre Manager.
- 1.5** Each representative is responsible for paying they own nomination/entry fees
- 1.6** Representatives and subsidies representative need to be approved by the BTTA committee
- 1.7** Subsidies will only be paid to Representatives that regularly participate in BTTA club activities.

BTTA Representatives at National Titles

No subsidies will be paid by BTTA to BTTA representatives at the annual National Titles.

The reasons for this policy include:

- a) Members are representing Qld not BTTA; and
- b) TTQ would be the appropriate body to apply for subsidies.
