The Ping-Pong-a-Thon is held annually each October, it supports people impacted by human trafficking & exploitation in Asia.

This year's Brisbane Law Pong final came down to Queensland Health & Freehills. Congratulations to Queensland Health who had a secret weapon - Brisbane Club's own, Alan Shaw. Alan helped Queensland Health claim the victory. Congrats too to Clayton UTZ for topping the fundraising dollars. Brisbane Law Pong has raised \$9,335 and across Australia the program has raised almost \$290,000.
