During 2021 the premiere Table Tennis event for Brisbane Table Tennis is the annual Brisbane Open.

In past years, more than 145 people from 20 different clubs across Australia have entered the tournament. With countless more who participate as officials, supporters and spectators.

- Valued at \$500 +GST





Here are some recent statistics:

- October 2020 edition: Open rate 32%. Click rate 11%.
- September 2020 edition: Open rate 34.7%. Click rate 11.5%
- August 2020 edition. Open rate 33.2%. Click rate 10%



RECENT OUTCOMES

Over the last two Brisbane Opens were very successful. The 2020 Open was not run due to COVID-19. We anticipate renewed interested for the 2021 event.

Recently a lot has happened.

- The **Centre Redevelopment** has continued. With additional LED lights on the courts, the installation of a lift, new entrance doors, and disabled toilets.
- During 2019 34 Brisbane Club members were named in **Queensland's Top 10**, more than any other club. In 2019 we had the best senior players in the State, Bruno Levis and Min Hyung Lee.
- **The Global Games** was held at the Brisbane Centre seeing some of the best special needs players from across the world compete.
- **Queensland Veteran Championships 2021** are scheduled to be held at Brisbane Table Tennis 22 25 July.
